Wills and Beneficiaries

It is a simple task to include individuals or organizations in your will. Pre-prepared forms can be used to create a will or legal counsel can assist in creating a customized last testament to your liking. Usually the best and most reliable method of designating individual gifts is using a percentage of your remaining estate for each beneficiary included in your will.

An IRA or other investment accounts can also have beneficiaries attached to them. This is a simple procedure and can be done



online if your account has online access.

Charitable Gift Annuities

These are simple documents that can be prepared by many not-for-profit organizations or your bank. They can provide you (and if desired, a second family member) with on-going income for life while also receiving a charitable deduction for a portion of your gift. In this way, you have income to help meet your on-going needs while providing a sizable and immediate gift to a ministry you value. Interest returned from these annuities can often be higher than what is commonly available.

Either of these options provide you with continuing re-



sources to meet your current or future needs, while enabling you to give a gift larger than you might otherwise be able to provide during your lifetime. Larger gifts like these play a critical role in providing the level of resources necessary to benefit those served by organizations like Calvary Homes.
