needs will be met as they age. With the increasing longevity of seniors, it is becoming more common to see lifespans exceeding 100 years. Because the cost of care can exceed \$100,000 annually, few individuals can afford the cost for an extended period of time. Did you know that:

- ◆ over 70% of Pennsylvania nursing care residents have depleted their own resources and rely on Medicaid.
- ◆ for personal care residents in Pennsylvania, no viable government funding program exists to support their care.
- ◆ Calvary Homes' residents continue to receive the care they need in the level of living best-suited to their needs. Because of this, Calvary Homes' benevolent care costs exceed \$520,000 annually.
- ◆ without adequate donor support, fees must increase for existing residents to cover these shortfalls in funding.
