

The COVID-19 virus continue to bring us many challenges each day with how fast it is spreading. The safety of our residents and staff continue to be our first priority. Our Leadership and Health Services Teams continue to get daily updates from the Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH), Centers for Disease Control (CDC) the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Pennsylvania of Human Services (DHS).

We no longer have any flu cases in our Health Care Center. Due to COVID-19 we are not allowing any family or visitors to those in the Health Care Center except for if a resident is at an End of Life situation.

We are also not allowing any visitors to those in Personal Care/Garden View except for those residents at an End of Life situation. All of our Personal Care/Garden View residents are having all of their meal provided in their neighborhood which is going well.

Residents that live in Hamilton, Nissley & Cathedral residents are not allowed visitors. The only exception are for those residents that have someone to help them with a care need. Those folks will be screened and have their temperature taken when they come in and will have their temperature taken when they leave. Outside housekeepers are not allowed to come in.

We continue to remind all of our staff of our infection controls & prevention plans that we have in place and have been trained on. All of our staff go through a screening process and have their temperature taken and are evaluated to see if they can are well enough to work. We are also taking the temperature of our employees as they leave work as per guidance from the PA Department of Health.

Everyone should be practicing good infection control habits. These include washing hands on a regular basis, covering your mouth with your arm or a tissue when you sneeze or cough and not visiting if you have had a fever or respiratory infection over the past few days.
