



Calvary Homes continues to be committed to the ongoing safety and health of all our residents and team members as we all deal with the COVID-19 virus. All our team members continue to follow all infection control procedures.

On January 5, 2020 we had 4 Healthcare residents result positive for COVID-19. Of all these residents, only one resident has mild symptoms. Also, on January 5, 2021 we had one Healthcare employee result positive for COVID-19. This employee is a direct caregiver and has mild symptoms. On January 6, 2021 we had two Healthcare employees result positive for COVID-19. One employee is a direct caregiver and has no symptoms. The other employee is not a direct caregiver and has no symptoms.

We presently have 10 residents in our RED zones (2 in our lower level & 8 on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor) of our health care center. We continue to work very hard to contain the spread of COVID. This is an effort to localize positive cases and minimize traffic. All of our residents in health care are being tested at least weekly for COVID. We also monitor their vital signs at least 2 times a day.

We continue to conduct COVID testing twice a week for our health care team members due to the positivity rate being above 10% (on 1/5 the rate was 15.3%). Our health care team members continue to wear full PPE. We have a number of team members that are out due to testing positive for the virus, have been exposed directly with someone who has the virus or are having symptoms for the virus and are waiting results from being tested.

From Tess Picarelli, Personal Care Administrator –

On 1/2/21 a PC team member in was exposed to someone who tested positive for COVID-19. All residents have been placed on quarantine which will end on 1/15/21. We are requiring all team member that go into a resident's room to wear full Personal Protective Equipment [PPE]. Weekly testing continues.

Unfortunately, this places Personal Care back to the prerequisite phase of our re-opening plan. We will continue to follow guidelines from the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services [DHS], Pennsylvania Department of Health [DOH], and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention [CDC] to reduce the risk of COVID-19.

We are also mandated to follow guidelines for testing and visitation related to the transmission rate of positive cases in our county. Since our county's transmission rate is currently at a substantial rate of 15.3 percent, visitation is restricted back to Step 1 of the Re-opening Implementation Plan dated 9/15/20 which is posted on Calvary's website. Testing and visitation restrictions shall continue as mandated per the county's positivity rate.

We understand that communicating and seeing your loved one is important and we continue to offer ways to get you connected through video communications with the use of Facetime, Skype, or Facebook.
