



Calvary Homes continues to be committed to the ongoing safety and health of all our residents and team members as we all deal with the COVID-19 virus. All our team members continue to follow all infection control procedures.

At the present time there are no residents in our health care and personal care centers that have COVID or are being quarantined due to possible exposure.

The county positivity rate has gone down to 8.5% as of 3/2/2021. Once we go 14 days below 10% positivity rate our testing for our health care and personal care team members will go to once a week. In the mean time we continue to test our health care team members 2 times a week and our personal care team members 1 time a week. We have some team members that are out due to either having been exposed directly with someone who has the virus or are having symptoms for the virus and are waiting results from being tested.

Our health care residents will only be tested if we were to have an outbreak of the virus and our personal care residents will be tested if they have had contact with someone from outside of Calvary Homes.

We understand that communicating and seeing your loved one is important and we continue to offer ways to get you connected through video communications with the use of Facetime, Skype, or Facebook.
