To all Personal Care Residents and Families,

On September 07, 2021, one Personal Care team member tested positive for COVID-19. He/She last worked in Nissley PC and had minimal contact with residents or other staff. The team member is self-isolating at home until cleared to return to work.

Outbreak testing for all Personal Care residents and staff has been initiated. Indoor visitation, beyond compassionate care visits, and communal activities have been suspended for Nissley PC resident for a minimum of 14 days, pending outbreak testing. All residents, in all units, will be served their meals in their rooms. No additional positive cases have been identified for Baumgartner or Garden View; therefore, visitation and communal activities can resume for those units.

Calvary Homes remains committed to the health and safety of our residents, staff and community we serve. Throughout the pandemic we have followed, and will continue to follow, the guidance set forth by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Department of Health and Human Services (DHS), and Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to minimize the risk of COVID-19 transmission.
