



Calvary Homes continues to be committed to the ongoing safety and health of all our residents and team members as we all deal with the COVID-19 virus. All our team members continue to follow all infection control procedures.

The positivity rate in Lancaster County continues to go up. On 10/5/2021 the CDC website shows that the community transmission rate went from 11.50% to 12.85%. COVID testing for our health care and personal care team members that are not fully vaccinated continues to be done twice a week. If we have an outbreak of COVID in one of the facilities (health care or personal care) our testing will be increased for that area.

In our Independent Living area, we have one resident that has COVID. The person is quarantined and being monitored.

Visitation continues on even though the positivity rate is high. You can sign up to VISIT residents in our health care and personal care facilities on our website. Below are our visitation procedures.

****Visitation Procedures for Healthcare and Personal Care****

- Masks must be worn at all times.
- Indoor and outdoor visitation is permitted within regulatory guidelines.
- Indoor visits shall occur in the resident's room or in a neutral space, based the number of visitors.
- Visits are encouraged Monday-Sunday between 9:00am -7:00pm for 1 hour.
- We strongly encourage no visits during meal times.

- Residents who are fully vaccinated may choose to have close contact, including touch, while wearing a well fitted mask and both parties performing hand hygiene before and after.
